



Agreement to Participate

Both students and parents should recognize that the trip coordinators for Crossroads Student Travel make every effort to design a safe, educational experience for every participant on the trip. Before a student is allowed to participate on a Crossroads Student Travel trip, each participant and parent must agree to the stipulations stated below.

Release of Liability

I fully recognize that the student participant's school does not assume any liability risk for a Crossroads Student Travel trip. In recognition that any type of travel may entail some degree of risk, I confirm that I assume full responsibility for personal injury, accidents or illness, including death that may result from my own negligence. I also assume responsibility for damage to or loss of personal property as the result of any accident that may occur. In consideration of services or property provided, I, for myself and any minor children for which I am parent legal guardian or otherwise responsible, do hereby release any coordinator, teacher chaperone or volunteer on a Crossroads Student Travel trip from any liability and waive any claim for damage arising from any cause whatsoever.

Acceptance of Personal Responsibility

Crossroads Student Travel upholds a strict policy of personal responsibility on the part of any participant. Students are not allowed to drink alcohol, take any kinds of drugs or any other illegal substance or engage in any other type of unsavory activity during a Crossroads Student Travel trip. At the discretion of the trip coordinators, students may be sent home for failing to comply with the standards of a trip. Refunds are not granted to students who are sent home early. Parents must also agree to pay any additional travel expenses for students sent home early. The Crossroads coordinators reserve the right to notify the SP Dean of Students' office of any infraction of a student participant.
